HIV self- test kits are easy to use. They give you a choice in how you can learn your HIV status - anytime, anywhere, & with anyone you choose.

MY TEST IS NEGATIVE

HIV self-tests are highly accurate. with a 99% accuracy rate 12 weeks after the potential exposure to HIV.

If you are testing before you reach the 12 week period, it is best to retest at 6 weeks and then again 3 months after your potential exposure.

First, take a moment for yourself, a reactive test can feel overwhelming. What's important to know is that with treatment you can live a long, happy, healthy life. Reach out to someone you trust for support or contact us to speak with a tester.

The next step is to confirm your self test results with a standard HIV blood test.

You can book an anonymous confirmation test at either of POWCHC's locations (see back for details) OR with any anonymous clinic near you. When doing a confirmatory test, be sure to keep your anonymous HIV test code, you might need it later.

If you chose a clinic that does NOT offer an anonymous service your name. DOB, gender, contact information and results will be shared with your local Public Health Unit for the purpose of support follow up and contact tracing.
