SPiN is a Toronto Central LHIN initiative that involves several CHCs offering a range of health and psychosocial supports for the marginalized patients of solo physicians in our community.

SKILLS AND QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Graduate degree in relevant discipline from a recognized university.
2. Three to five years providing counselling and case management services to individuals and groups who are marginalized, preferably in a community health setting
3. Proficiency in mental health assessment, psychosocial deficits; and brief solution counseling techniques that are trauma-informed and strength-resiliency-based for working with individuals, couples, families and communities.
4. Demonstrated ability to work with multi-disciplinary teams.
5. Proficiency in the use of computers and various software applications.

As a skilled counsellor with a track record for teamwork and flexibility, you will be highly committed to working within anti-oppression, harm reduction and cultural safety frameworks. You will also be keenly responsive to working across diverse populations, including Indigenous Peoples, racialized, LGBTQ, substance-using populations, and young people.

The successful candidate will demonstrate a willingness to participate in Parkdale Queen West's commitment to becoming a discrimination-free health centre and an ability to work interdependently and respectfully in a multi-disciplinary team.
